

I am working on a Deseret Unicode Keyboard with the following updated encoding. Capitals would use the corresponding Capital keys. All other keys would have their normal function so that numbers, etc. would not be affected. Also, for example, when you type the first i it turns into ᠊ and then when you type the second i the ᠊ turns into ᠋. The \ key can be used to force d, g, h, n, p, s, t, w, y, z encoding.
